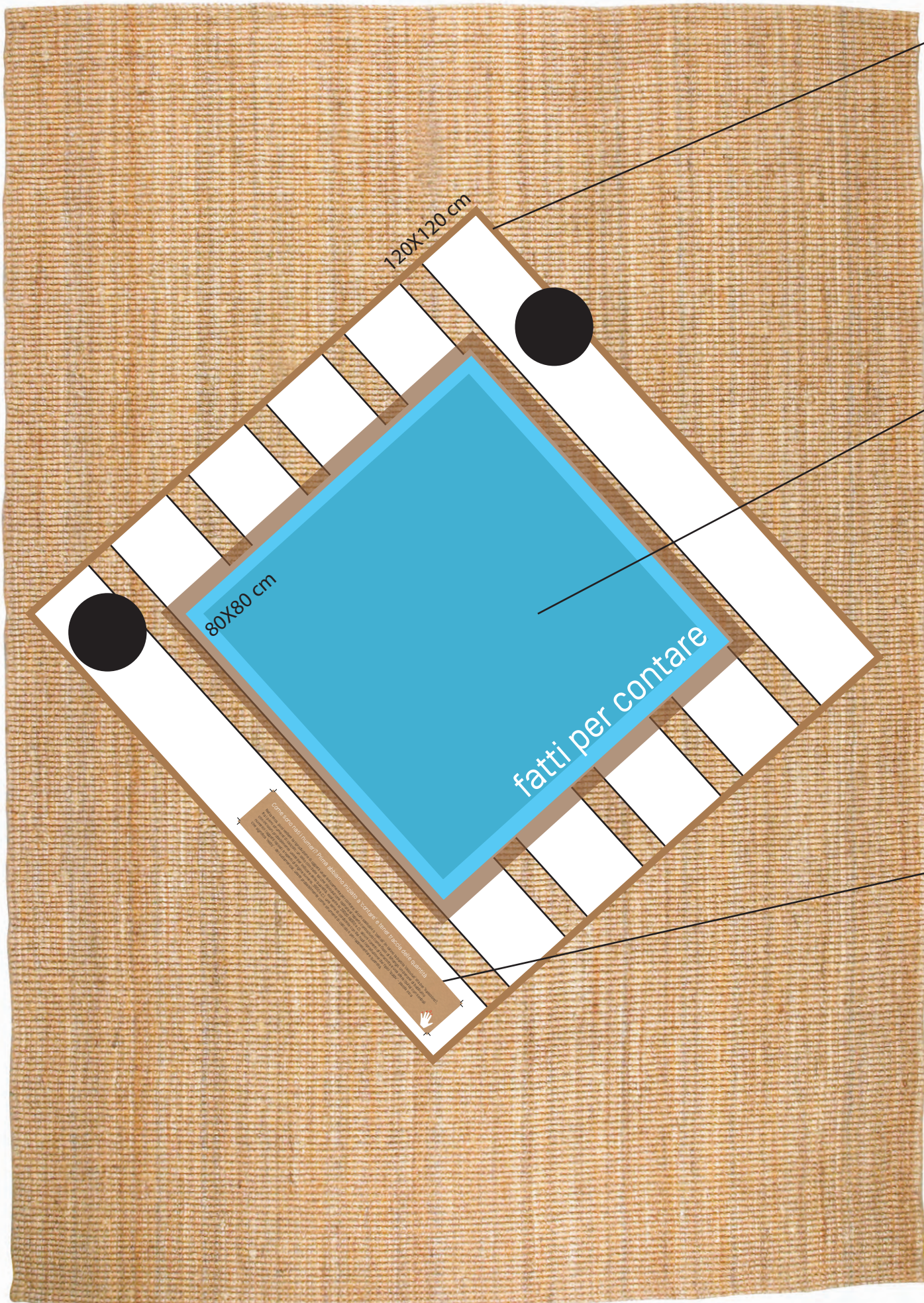


IKEA coconut fiber rug: 180x250 cm



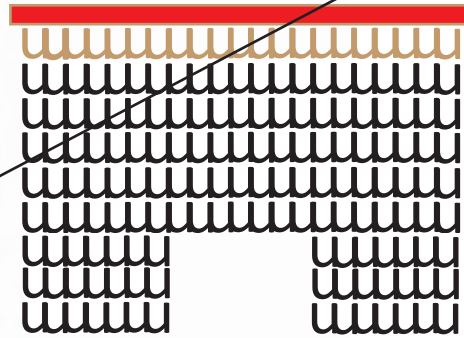
VIEW FROM ABOVE

120 x 120 cm pallets with wheels.

Material baskets (ropes, pebbles) mper count.

Around the display case on the pallet some stations with cardboard tables with mancala style games

Inside the display case are reproductions of ancient objects used for counting: ishango bone, bulle (made of clay), quipu (rope with knots as shown)



Layered honeycomb cardboard little table with red-colored MDF cover (60x60cm) - see photo

Honeycomb cardboard layer thickness 4.6 cm. Coffee table created with 6 layers of honeycomb cardboard (60x60 cm) and 3 layers for feet (4 feet of 15x15 cm).



For each little table there are two pillows and an ethnomathematical game: mancala, shax, eye horus

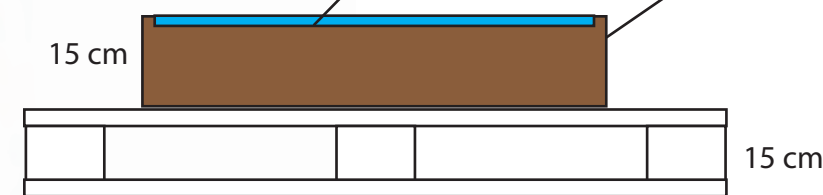

Removable plexiglass cover (for use as a chalkboard)

The display case is a cardboard and MDF box with a plexiglass lid and sand inside (to be used to make marks on the sand)

## MATERIAL LIST:

- No. 3 cardboard side tables with red MDF top / 60 x 60 cm / height 45 cm
- Pallet base 120x120 cm
- Showcase (80x80 cm) made of MDF and cardboard with plexiglass cover, inside is arranged a layer of sand of about 2 cm
- Small cardboard panel with contents
- "Made to count" plexiglass sticker ("FAIT POUR COMPTER")
- Cards for ethnic games
- IKEA rope rug 180x250 cm
- Planting games (Mancala,...)
- Bedouin tent material (as desired) - see photo
